

PageStore Version 3.1 Release Notes

ABOUT PGESTORE 3.1

PageStore 3.1 is the first major upgrade of PageStore 3, the multi-platform solution used by advertising agencies, designers and publishers to distribute PDF files which have been generated and validated in QuickPrint.

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

OTHER INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

1. To enable communications, you will need to contact your account representative for the **iconfig.dat** configuration file to suit your site.
2. If you are also using QuickPrint 5, its **Accept** folder must be set as the **QPDROPBOX**. This can only be done through QuickPrint 5.
3. **JobsDatabase.db** and **Quickcuts.db** must be located on the machine where the PageStore Server is installed.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- An active Quickcut account is required for PageStore.
- Under Mac OS X.4, Spotlight may interfere with the operation of PageStore 3x. It is recommended that you add the PageStore Workspace and Database folders to the Spotlight privacy tab.
- Antivirus software may interfere with the operation of PageStore 3x. It is recommended that you set up an exclusion for the PageStore Workspace and Database.
- Scripting is now enabled. However, please note:
 - Scripts that were used in earlier builds of PageStore may need the file to be renamed. Script filenames that contain bullet points – e.g. **•Periodical** – will now need to be renamed with no bullets – e.g. **_Periodical**.
 - Script filenames must have a **.ici** suffix.
 - ICI scripts such as **iciNewsProduction.ici** should be renamed to **ici4NewsProduction.ici**.
 - Script generated data that was previously written to the Script Console on Mac is not displayed automatically. On the Mac, you can view this data in the **Console** application (in the **Utilities** folder). In Windows, this data is written to the **Console.log** file, which is located in the **PageStore** application folder.

WHAT'S NEW IN PAGESSTORE 3.1

Scripting

Scripting is now enabled, providing the ability to write customised scripts for internal workflow.

Localisation

A German-language version is now available. Asian language versions are in development.

Automation functions

An **Enable/Disable** flag for QAutomate has been added in the Admin Preferences window. The Automation menu is only available if this flag is set. The flag is turned off by default.

Automatic notification of new version

On opening, PageStore 3.1 displays a dialog which contains download and install instructions if a new version of the software has been released.

Soft proofing

A new Soft Proof Approved field shows whether the PDF has been approved/not approved by a soft proofing device. This is required for clients who have purchased the ICS/Adstream Integrated Proofing Solution.

Improved Production Gateway

The Production Gateway no longer defaults to the Production folder. When browsing for a path, it now defaults to the last path that was selected.

Job Details Window changes

"Zoom to fit" has been changed to "Scale to fit" as it was in PageStore 2.

Active Job Viewer changes

If the window is refreshed the current selections are retained.

Refresh button now updates all relevant settings.

Documentation

The on-line help has been updated.

New user guides are available on the PageStore Support site.

MAJOR BUG FIXES IN PAGESSTORE 3.1

- Carbon/Cocoa bug/limitation for PageSetup and Print.
- Wrong data in the originator/booking number fields in printouts.
- Format of Run Date in proof printout is now DD-MMM-YYYY again, instead of YYYYMMDD.
- Fixed bug whereby the Unique checkbox in Transmission Viewer was preserved but not being correctly applied to the contents.
- Fixed small leak in the *prompt user for input* code.
- The state of the Use Extension/Prefix checkbox in the Production Gateway dialog is now remembered between usage of gateway instantiation and also application sessions.
- Fixed code in the Authentication dialog to no longer pass a nil computer name to the field if returned as nil by the operating system.
- Bug 577 where a call only available in OS 10.4 was causing problems in 10.3 has been fixed.
